2. ADMISSION





2.1. Eligibility for Admission

- 1. As per NEP 2020 candidate must have passed the higher secondary Part –II examination (10+2 pattern) of the Jammu and Kashmir State Board of School Education, CBSE or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto be eligible for admission to four- years under graduate programmes (FYUGP).
- 2. Admission shall be on the basis of CUET merit (2024) and availability of seats in a particular Major subject.

2.2. Admission Procedure

- 1. Admission of students to the four- years under graduate programmes will be strictly as per Merit Lists provided on Samarth portal.
- 2. Admission will be provided in the three Major subjects viz. Political Science, Education and Geography as per sanction provided by Higher Education.
- 3. Change of Subject/Stream is not permissible after admission.
- 4. Merit lists of the candidate selected for the admission shall be displayed on the College Notice Board and College Website(www.gdcnagrota.org).

2.3. Documents Required

For State Board Students

- Marks card /Diploma of 10th class (3 self-attested photocopies).
- Marks card of 12th class (3 self-attested photocopies).
- > Provisional and Character Certificate in original from the institution last attended.
- Three self-attested passport size photographs.
- Category Certificate issued by the concerned SDM/ Tehsildar only (if applicable)
- Photocopy of Aadhaar Card.
- ➤ Affidavit from 1st Class Magistrate in case of Academic Gap.
- > Anti-Drug Declaration Form signed by the student.

For CBSE / Other Board Student

Besides the above-mentioned documents, the following are required

- Eligibility Certificate
- Migration Certificate in original, along with photocopy.
- Transfer Certificate in original, along with photocopy

Original Documents shall be required at the time of Verification for confirmation of Admission.

3.3 The main features of the programme are: -

- ◆ All Bachelor's Degree programmes are full-time regular for the specified duration as per National Education Policy (NEP-2020), with Multiple Entry and Exit options at various stages after even semesters.
- ◆ The students have ample opportunities to accumulate credits by opting for Major, Minor, Multidisciplinary, Value Added, Skill and Ability Enhancement courses
- As per the UGC Guidelines for Multiple Entry and Exit in Academic Programmes offered in Higher Education Institutions, candidates who secure a minimum CGPA of 7.5 in a three-year Bachelor's Degree Programme shall be allowed to continue studies in the fourth year of the undergraduate programme to pursue and complete the Bachelor's Degree with Research/ Honours.

- Each student shall have to opt for Two Disciplines of his / her choice (One as a Major and One as a Minor) from the same stream based on interest and eligibility.
- In addition, the student shall opt for **Multidisciplinary Courses one** each in first three semesters with condition that the courses have not been studied in 10+2. The courses should also be different from the Major / Minor Courses as it has to be chosen from another stream.
- Besides the above three disciplines each student shall have to opt for **One Skill Enhancement Course (SEC)** vertical from a pool of such courses in the first three Semesters.
- A student has to also choose **One Ability Enhancement Courses (AECs)** in each of the first three Semesters as per the scheme.
- A student also has to study four Value Added Courses (VACs) two each in first two Semesters.



5. EXAMINATION





4.1 Eligibility Criteria to Appear in Examination

A regular candidate intending to appear in the Examination of the programme shall be required to satisfy the following conditions: -

- a. Has been on rolls of the college for one academic semester preceding the examination with at least 75% of attendance in Theory, Tutorial/Practical training/field work prescribed in the syllabi for the semester,
- b. Has exhibited good moral conduct in the college.
- c. Has secured pass marks in internal assessment.
- d. Has submitted his examination form along with the requisite fee.
- e. Students who after having undergone a regular Programme of study and having completed all conditions of eligibility for appearing in a Semester End Examination in the Course/s including minimum attendance requirement having passed in internal assessment and having either failed to pass the Semester End Examination in the Course/s or been unable to appear in the examination in the Course/s will be eligible to appear as Private candidate in the examination by submitting application in the prescribed form along with prescribed fees to reach the Controller of Examinations, within the dates fixed for this purpose.

Any candidate, who falls short of attendancein a course in a semester, shall not be eligible to appear in that particular course(s) in which he/she is falling short of attendance. However, he/she shall be entitled to appear in the course(s) in the next session after attending the deficit number of classes in thenext session.

4.2 Promotion to Next Semester

- a) A student will be eligible for promotion from semester-I to semester-II if he/she has secured pass marks in internal assessments of all papers of the semester-1.
- b) A student will be eligible for promotion from semester-II to semester III provided he/she has earned at least 50% of total credits of the semester-I as well as passed in internal assessments of all papers of semester-II.
- c) A student will be eligible for promotion from semester-III to semester-IV if he/has secured pass marks in internal assessment of all papers of semester-III.
- d) A student will be eligible for promotion from semester-IV to semester-V provided he/she has passed till semester-II and 50% of the total credits of semester-III as well as passed in internal assessments of all papers of semester-IV.
- e) A student will be eligible for promotion from semester-V to VI if he/she secured pass marks in internal assessments of all papers of the semester-V.





5. EXAMINATION



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4.2 Promotion to Next Semester (Contd.)

- f) Only those candidates who has successfully completed first five semester with 75% marks and above shall be allowed to continue fourth year of the undergraduate programme to obtain the bachelor's degree (Honours with research).
- g) A student will be eligible for promotion from semester-VII to semester-VIII if he/she has secured pass marks in internal assessments of all papers of the semester-VII.
- h) Candidate who successfully completed their four years bachelor's degree with Honours/Honours with research are eligible to enter the "Two Semester Master's Degree Programme".
- i) Candidates who successfully complete their four years bachelor's degree (Honours with research) are eligible to enter the "Doctoral (Ph.D) Programme" in a relevant subject if he/she full fills the Criterion requirement as per NHEQF.
- j) A student who has to reappear in a paper(s) prescribed for semester-VI and VIII shall appear in the supplementary examination.





6. CO/EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES



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6.1 Literary and Cultural Committee

Literary and Cultural Committee of GDC Nagrota has been organizing various related activities from time to time to enhance the talent of the students and hone in their writing and imaginative skills.

6.2 NSS

National Service Scheme was introduced in 1969. It's primary objective was to develop the personality and character of youth. The NSS unit of GDC Nagrota has been conducting various events from time to time, with the objective to channelize the student's energies in the right direction.
